COMPLAINT INFORMATION TOOL

Purpose: The Complaint Information Tool helps summarise details of the complaint, including the critical information investigators need to begin planning the investigation process and interviews. For example, if the survivor is a child, a specialist in child interviewing should be used.

How to use this tool: Investigation managers should fill out this tool in order to provide as much information to investigators as possible. As information emerges, investigation managers and investigators must continue to fill in the required information. More information about the complaint information tool can be found in section 3.1.1 of the *Sexual Exploitation, Abuse and Harassment (SEAH) Investigation Guide.*

Definition of key components

- Survivor The person who is or has been sexually exploited, abused, or harassed (SEAH).
- Reporter: The person reporting the SEAH complaint, if they are not the survivor.
- Subject of Complaint: The person alleged to have perpetrated the misconduct in the complaint.
- Code of conduct policy: The (potentially violated) set of standards to which organisational staff must adhere.
